### New Antennas for Clearfield EMA Station

Allen K3HOC reports that the three new Diamond X50 UHF/VHF antennas were installed on the Clearfield County EMA Building tower during the week of May 18th. These antenna are exclusively for amateur radio use and replace the three aging UHF/VHF antennas that have been on the tower for decades. In addition, the coax runs down the tower have also been replaced as part of the project and in the radio room he has labeled each coax so we know for certain which antenna we're connecting to.

As you will recall, one of the three older UHF/VHF antennas on the tower had failed. It was literally broken in two and swaying in the wind. It was thought that these UHF/VHF antennas were original to the amateur radio installation. Our assumption was that if one failed, the other two are probably not that far behind it. The county officials agreed and all three were replaced. Please keep in mind that this project was funded by the

## CCARC Field Day 2026

ARRL Field Day 2026 will take place June 27-28, 2026. The 27-hour event runs from 1800 UTC Saturday to 2059 UTC Sunday. This year's theme is "Amateur Radio: A National Resource", highlighting public service and emergency preparedness.

Here at the Clearfield County Amateur Radio Club we have in recent years participated in Field Day from a remote location near Penfield. This is a camp owned by Harvey N3RTK. Harvey has once again offered his camp for our Field Day event, however at the April CCARC meeting there was a discussion about the advantages and disadvantages of this location.

One suggestion was to move our Field Day event to the Lawrence Township Recreational Park on Fire Tower Road to the South of Clearfield. This location would provide a more central location that visitors might perceive to be "not that far". Our Penfield site suffered from a perception of being really far away and this could solve that issue. Tim N3PUL was asked at the April CCARC meeting to check into the possibility of using the Lawrence Township site for Field Day operations. He has



since received approvals from the Township Supervisors and has also been told that electrical power will be available for our operations. Tim N3PUL also suggested that he may bring his telescope equipment for some nighttime sky viewing. And he was assured that overnight camping would not be an issue.

At the April meeting the topic was tabled citing lack of information about alternate locations. With Tim's research and discussions with the

Lawrence Township Supervisors, we appear to have the needed information. At our Mat 2026

meeting the topic will be taken up again and plans firmed up.

Weather you're an experienced operator, or relatively new to HF operations, Field Day is an exceptional opportunity to either teach skills to others or get some first hand experience on the HF bands. There will be hundreds of other stations on the air during this contest and it can be very fast paced at times. It's an experience for sure. If you haven't participated in Field Day in the past, you should really consider it.

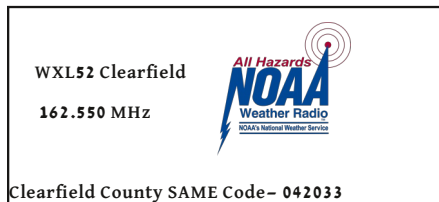

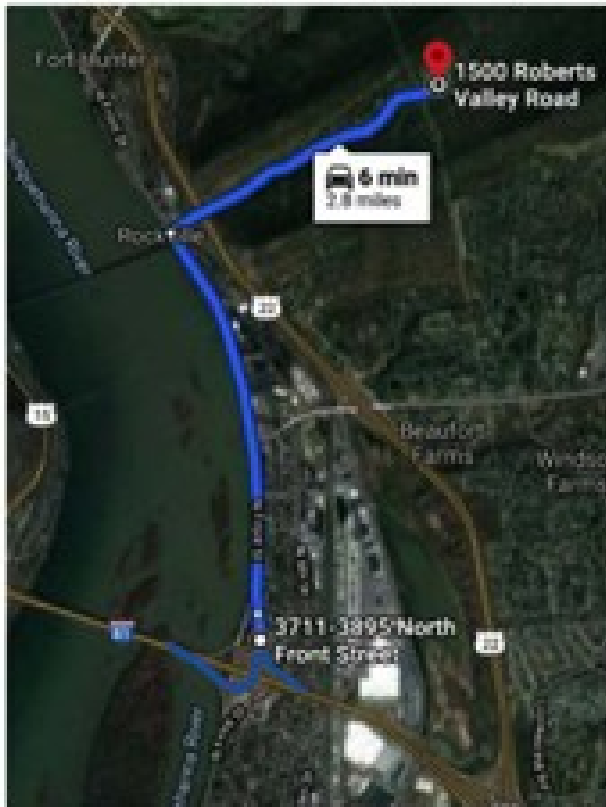

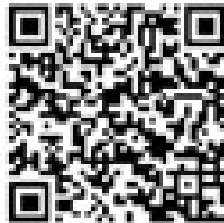

HRAC Firecracker (continued from front):

### DA RULES TO KEEP EVERYONE HAPPY:

1. **HAVE FUN** and use common sense and politeness for your enjoyment and security. This is a family-like event.
2. **ENTRANCE:** By entering or participating in the HRAC Firecracker Hamfest, you agree de facto notice to hold harmless HRAC (the renter) and the Harrisburg Postal Workers (the landlord) for losses or injury of property and person, and are subject to their representative's direction. *Professional security is not provided.*
3. **YOU MUST PAY TO ENTER.** Attempting to avoid payment at the designated entrance is considered statutory Fraud.
4. **IF YOU LEAVE THE GROUNDS,** your ticket stub is your re-entry.
5. **A PAID TICKET** is given to you at the designated entrance, which awards prizes, and are pulled at random times during the event. **However, the more tickets you buy, the better your chances of winning!** All award decisions are final.
6. **CHILDREN UNDER 12 ARE FREE.** Non-licensed individuals over 12 pay the full entrance fee.
7. **TAILGATING.** Although there is a flat entrance fee for tailgaters and general admission, tailgaters are voluntarily asked to limit up to 2, 10'x6' spaces. You must use any space you claim, and use only what you need.

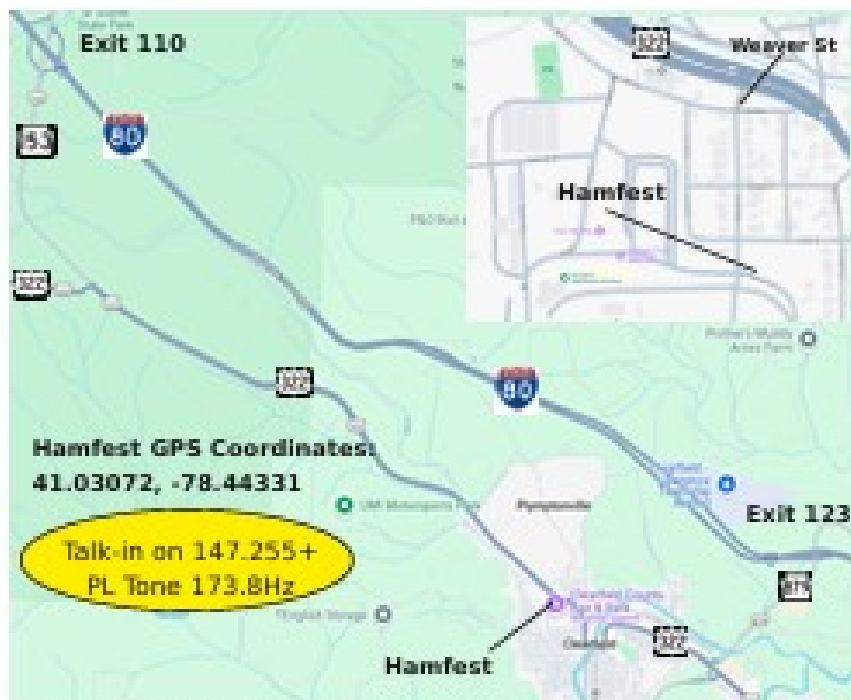
